For your cabin

Note: **NO** nails, tacks, push-pins, staples or tape

- Pillow and twin-bed sheets; sleeping bag or **warm** blanket
- Foam/air mattress pad
- Two bath towels (one to use while the other dries)
- Flashlight, battery-powered lantern and extra batteries
- Alarm clock and extra batteries
- Window covering e.g., two extra sheets or tablecloths; safety pins
- Clothesline, clothes pins, clothes hangers
- Mirror
- Floor mats
- Camp chairs
- Mouse-proof container/cooler (if you plan to keep food in your cabin)
- Personal drinking mug (also, available for purchase at the Bookstore)
- Fireplace matches, newspaper

For your body

- Cozy, snuggly P]'s
- Earplugs
- Lightweight clothing for daytime
- Warm** outerwear for mornings and evenings; gloves, hat, scarves
- Hiking clothes: protective long sleeved shirt, long pants, walking shoes
- Party clothes for evening dances
- Theme party duds: "Paradise Island", "SparkleMania"
- Personal medications
- Fragrance-free personal hygiene products
- Fragrance-free, DEET-**free** mosquito repellent
- Shower shoes e.g., flip-flops
- Sunhat, sunglasses
- Swimsuit
- Light rain jacket, umbrella

- Shoes: country dancing, ballroom, clogging (without taps!)
- Musical instruments
- Sheet music, books; music stand
