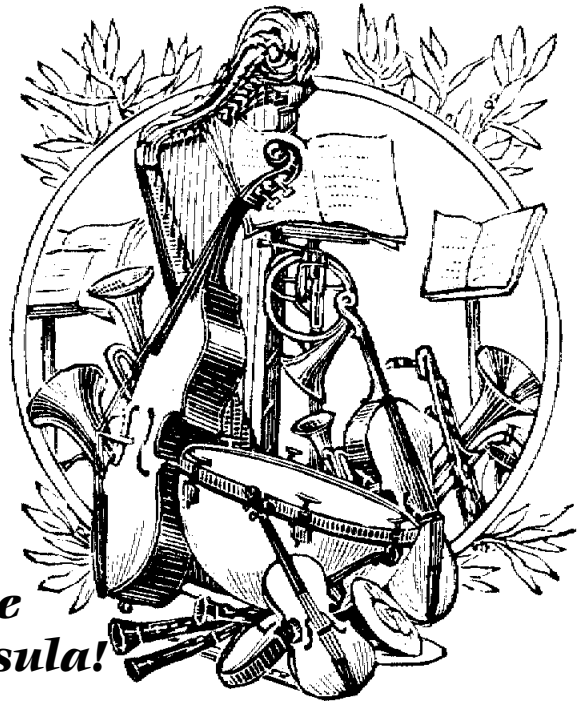

English Country Dance is the ancestor of contra dancing, cousin to Scottish Country Dance, and like both, is community dancing—you dance with your partner, and with everyone else in your set. All dances are taught, no experience is required, and you don't need to bring a partner—traditionally, one changes partners after every dance. We always dance to live music, a gorgeous repertoire ranging from music of the mid-17th century to modern-day compositions. Bring dancing shoes, doors open at 7pm.
