Fun for singles, couples, and families! Beginners Welcome!

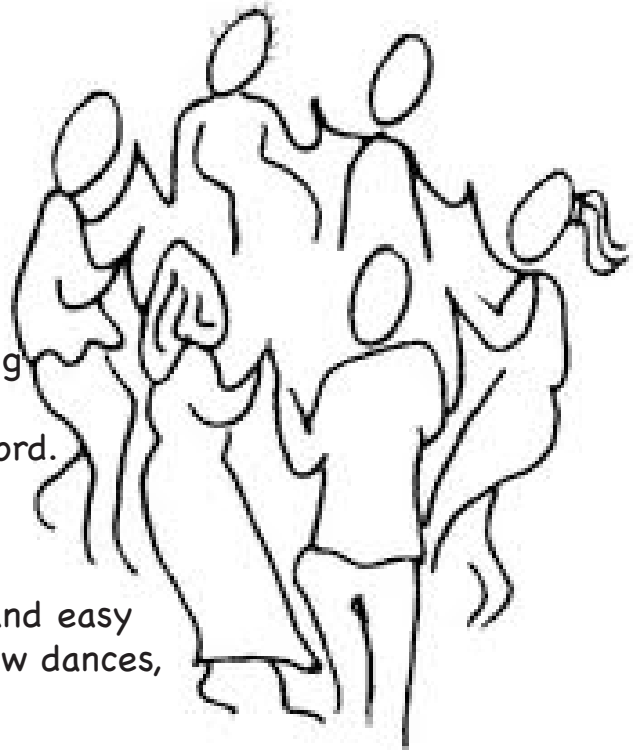
First and Third Sunday afternoons each month, 2:30-5:30 pm
