Join us for Northern California's premiere Contra Dance weekend: *hot* dancing in the *cool* of a San Francisco summer. We're located in San Francisco's famous Sunset district, just half a mile from Ocean Beach, overlooking Lake Merced, so we can take full advantage of the sea breezes and San Francisco's famous fog. This year's theme is *Sunrise in the Sunset*, so dress in your brightest sunrise colors and come dance!

The Syncopaths:

From dance floors to concert halls, the *Syncopaths* bring a fresh, contemporary spin to music and songs rooted in the Scottish, Irish, and American folk traditions. Evolving beyond their contra dance origins, they are creating a "chamber folk" sound characterized by the compelling, rhythmic interplay of fiddle and mandolin, rich vocals, and unexpected colors and rhythms from the piano and bodhrán. The exuberant joy they derive from the music and each other is palpable and contagious. The *Syncopaths* are equally at home with pulsing, high-energy dance tunes and beautiful, contemplative songs. They ably stretch melodic boundaries while keeping a steady, compelling, danceable beat. **Ashley Broder** on mandolin, **Christa Burch** on bodhrán and vocals, **Jeff Spero** on piano, and **Ryan McKasson** on fiddle.



The Morrison Brothers:

Maybe you've already noticed the unusual age spread these brothers display. In fact, though all brothers to someone, only **Will** and **Owen** are actually brothers to each other. **Jim** is their dad and the band happened in the course of

raising a family. They have played for contra, square and Irish set dancing since Owen was 15. Today Owen plays with about 6 different bands and is a full time guitarist. Will is an electrical engineer but finds time to drum with a couple of other bands too. Jim fixes computers by day and plays on the porch in the evenings. The Morrisons will be joined by Nathan Wilson from Lexington, Kentucky on bass.

party. Beth calls high-energy, turbocharged squares and smooth flowing contras. She is known for her quick no-nonsense walk throughs and effective teaching for both the newest dancers and the most seasoned of dancers. Beth's dances are always a guaranteed whoop and aholler good time!

Will Mentor is a contra and square dance caller from Northern Vermont known for his clear teaching, upbeat wit, and relaxed stage presence. He loves to choreograph evenings with a variety of dances and tempos that at times surprise and always delight, all the while keeping intact his



guiding principle as a caller: "It's about the dancers!"
