FALL FROLICK is an English dance weekend sponsored by the Bay Area Country Dance Society. The weekend provides an opportunity for dancers, callers, and musicians to explore the extraordinary range of English country dance and related dance forms, and discover and learn from wonderful teachers and splendid musicians in a glorious setting. Fall Frolick is for all English country dancers and musicians, experienced and novice alike. Registrations must be received by November 1 to be considered in the lottery (if required). Please register early—space is limited.

NEW LOCATION: The Bishop's Ranch is in the wine country of northern California, 75 miles north of San Francisco. The facility has a beautiful dance hall with abundant natural light, and many lovely spaces for dance and music workshops, jamming, and parties. The airy and pleasant accommodations vary from cottages, each with its own living room and bathroom, to double and triple rooms with bathrooms. Linens are provided for all rooms. Bishop's Ranch staff provides tasty, wholesome food served in the roomy dining hall.

FEES: These include the entire program, from Friday evening to Sunday after lunch, and five meals, starting with Saturday breakfast. Total cost of the weekend is **\$375**, before subtracting any applicable discounts (see below). Full payment is due at the time of registration. Should that be a hardship for you, contact the registrar at bacdsfallfrolick@gmail.com. We will give a complete refund to anyone not accepted into the weekend.

COVID POLICY: In the face of all the COVID uncertainty, the committee has worked hard to make good choices that balance the safety of the community with enjoyment at camp. Full policy is on the Fall Frolick web page.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you cancel on or before November 10, you will receive a full refund. After November 10th, a \$50 registration fee is non-refundable, with the following exception: We will offer a full refund of your registration fee if you contract COVID-19 and will not have completed your isolation period before camp starts or are still symptomatic. We ask that you send us proof of a positive COVID-19 test. Other situations, such as close contact with a COVID-19 positive person, will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
