Note : Each Strain twice.

The first Couple fall back, and sides with the second Couple, then cast off and turn, and sides with the third Couple. Then first Man Hands round with his Partner, and both cast up. The first Man change places with the second Woman, and his Partner with the second Man, and all four move round into their own places. Then first Couple Right Hand and Left quite round with the second Couple into the second Couples place.

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
