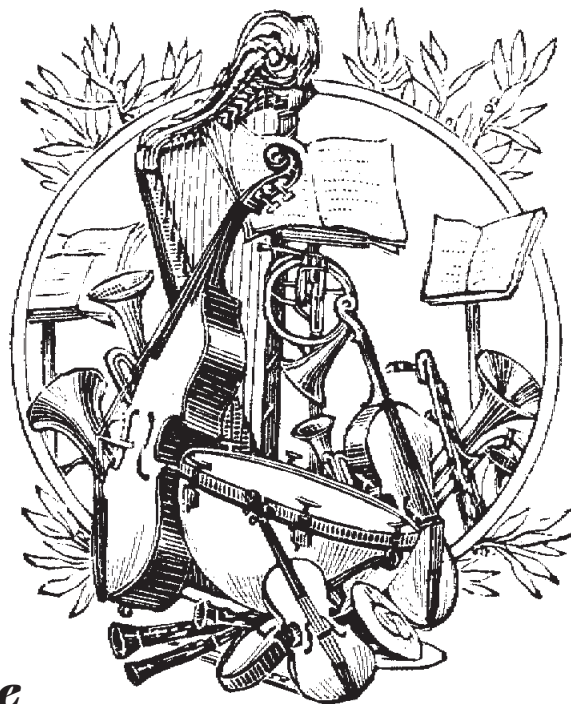


San Francisco English Country Dance
